Time Zones: Alaska is in the Alaska Time Zone. Alaska Time is 4 hours behind the Eastern time Zone. The Yukon Territory and British Columbia are on Pacific Time, 3 hours behind the Eastern Time Zone.

Passport Required: Travel on these tours requires a valid passport. Passports should be valid for six months beyond your return date. While on tour the safety of your passport is your responsibility. Always keep your passport with you, not in your luggage. It is recommended that you keep two copies of your passport; one with you on tour in a separate location from the actual passport and one at home where someone can access it if necessary. Your passport will be needed at airport ticket counters, border crossings, immigrations and customs. Please forward a copy of the picture page of your passport to Holiday Vacations to ensure accuracy of all documents.

Currency: The unit of currency in Canada is the Canadian dollar. Currency exchange rates fluctuate on a daily basis. A helpful website for referencing current rates is www.oanda.com. The US dollar can often be used in Canada but you may receive Canadian currency as change for these transactions.

Electrical Current: Canada runs on the same electrical current and uses the same electrical outlets as the United States. You will not need to purchase a converter or adapter for your travels in Canada.

A Note on Travel to Canada: Even with a required passport, Canada considers people with certain criminal records as inadmissible. Canada classifies DWI's, DUI's, OWI's, DUAI's, and DWAI's as felonies and automatically considers a person inadmissible if they have one of these on their record. Other offences such as shoplifting, theft, or assault can bar entry even if committed decades ago. More information can be found at www.cbsa-asfc.gc.ca or contact a lawyer. Medical – Pregnancy: Due to limited medical facilities, we will not accept reservations for women who are 24 or more weeks pregnant at the time their travel concludes.

Shipboard Clothing: From 7 am – 6 pm guests are welcome to dress as they please with the exception of no swimwear in all public lounges and restaurants and no clothing with offensive language or graphics that distract from the comfort and well-being of others. The general shipboard style is elegant, but relaxed including jeans and Bermuda/ walking shorts.

In the evening – after 6 pm when dining in Amphora, Stella Bistro, or Cuadro 44 by Anthony Sasso, the dress code is country club-type clothing. For men – nice slacks, polo shirts, button-down shirts, shoes other than athletic shoes. Designer denim jeans without rips or holes or multiple colors are also acceptable. Sport coats are optional. Ties are not needed. For women – nice pants, skirts, tops, casual dresses, sundresses, nice sandals or casual shoes, and designer denim dress jeans not ripped or multi-colored or having holes. Blazers are optional.

Shipboard Internet Access: Windstar Cruises offers satellite internet capabilities on board available in a choice of internet packages. However, service can be unreliable or may not be available depending on the course and position of the ship. Wi-fi



service is available and is possible in most public areas, staterooms, and suites. Internet packages can be purchased prior to your cruise. Internet usage packages are based on the amount of data used.

Shipboard Money: Windstar's cashless society is designed to make your life on board as simple as possible. When you board, your account will already be active. You may make purchases by simply showing your guest identification card and signing a receipt. On embarkation day, you will need to register your credit card in order to use your onboard account for shipboard purchases. Windstar does not accept debit cards or prepaid cards. Your card will be preauthorized for USD \$600 per guest for your cruise. An incremental authorization will occur mid-cruise if your current balance exceeds the \$600 per person initial authorization. At the end of the cruise, you will receive a final statement, and your card will be charged only for the actual amount of your purchases. Please inform your credit card issuer in advance that your card will be used on a Windstar ship. This will help prevent delays in obtaining pre-authorization on board. Products and services on board are in USD. Windstar is not liable for any foreign exchange fees imposed by your card issuer, and there are no currency exchange services offered on board.
